

Gemstones in Biobelt

Amethyst

Has captivated people from all over the world for thousands of years. Its color is unique and seductive. The ancient Greeks believed this purple gemstone could prevent intoxication while other cultures believed it could heal and protect people.

Amethyst is known to emit negative ions. Negative ions are invisible, odorless molecules that we are exposed to in certain environments.

Tourmaline

Gemstones are pyroelectric, as well as piezoelectric meaning they have the amazing ability to create their own electric charge. This gem emits far infrared waves and creates negative ions. The name tourmaline comes from the Sinhalese words "tura mali" which translates to "stone with different colors." Tourmalines come in many shades of the color spectrum and no two are alike.

Green Jade

Is regarded as a symbol of the good, the beautiful and the precious. Jade has mystified and fascinated many different cultures for many centuries. It is often carved into beautiful sculptures and jewelry. In Asia, Jade is believed to have

healing and stability properties. They believe it protects the wearer from any negative energy or negative influences. The ancient people from the East have believed in the healing properties of Jade for hundreds of years.

Crystal

Is a clear solid material resembling ice and is usually identifiable by their geometric shape, consisting of flat faces. Crystals can be found in many modern electronic devices and is also used by alternative medicine healers.

Citrine

Elvan

Stones are harvested from the bottom of the seas surrounding Korea. The stone was discovered in China about 3000 years ago and found to contain minerals beneficial to the human body. It has been used in Eastern medicine and spas. Asian healers believe when heated, Elvan radiates a large amount of infrared rays.

Far Infrared Rays From Gemstones

What is the difference between heat and far infrared rays from gemstones? It is difficult for external heat to penetrate into our bodies, but far infrared rays from gemstones are believed to penetrate deeper into our bodies and generate intense frictional heat which stimulates our cells to move. Active movement of cells generates frictional heat and raises your body temperature. The gemstones used for far infrared rays in the Biobelt have a shorter wavelength and so have deeper impact power and generate heat more powerfully and comfortable than ordinary far infrared rays. The Biobelt warms up your body and keeps it warm as the far

infrared rays generate heat. Some diseases come from reduced body temperature. Such lowering of body temperature is called "cold hypersensitivity." A symptom of cold hypersensitivity is getting cold hands, feet and areas that are far from the heart and then an overall drop in body temperature. Overall blood circulation can be hindered due to lowering of temperature in hands and feet because capillary vessels are contracted.
